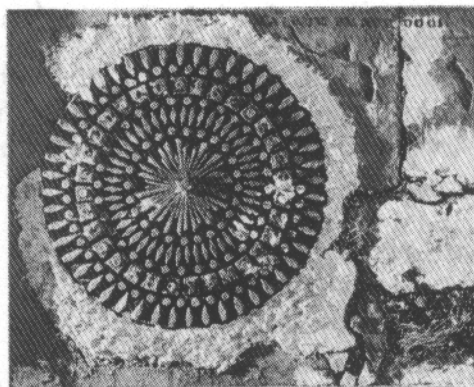

Bobbi Mastrangelo is internationally known for her evocative renderings of manhole covers with an environmental theme. The artist works in a variety of media from hand made paper for prints and foam, wood, acrylic, pebbles, cement, mud and moss for dimensional creations. She often employs a trompe l'oeil technique which fools the viewers. The covers look like heavy metal – like a section of street has been lifted from its urban environment and put on a wall or floor.

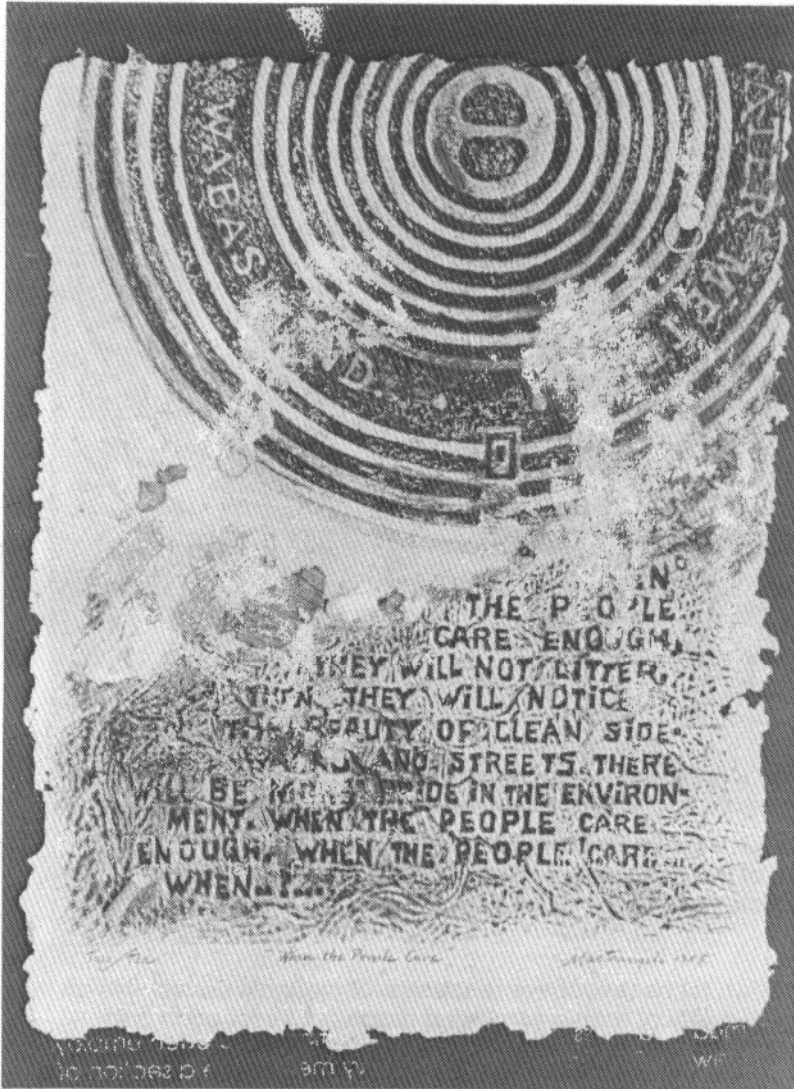


Keep Our Waters Pure

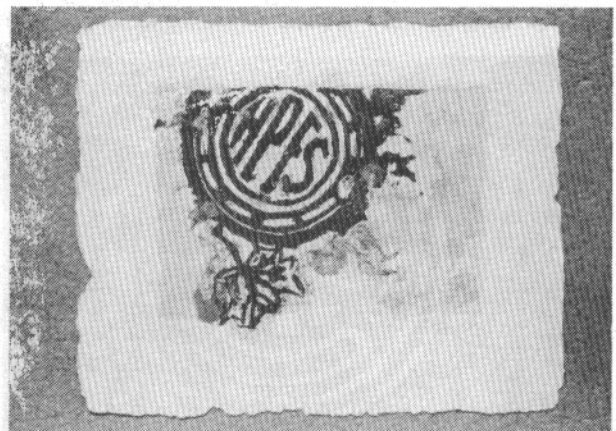
